John A. Feenan was named Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer of Styron in January 2012 and is responsible for corporate financial reporting, audit, treasury, tax, internal controls and corporate governance. Feenan served as Senior VP and Chief Financial Officer of the JMC Steel Group having been appointed to that role in February 2007. Additionally, Mr. Feenan served as a member of the disclosure, compliance, pension and ethics committees and an active participant in the Board and Audit Committees.

Prior to the JMC Steel Group, Mr. Feenan was the Chief Financial Officer of HB Fuller (NYSE: FUL) a \$2B global, specialty chemical firm.
